NARRATIVE: Your project narrative should discuss how your proposed project will have a significant impact on the advancement of your career. Use no more than one typed page. (13 sets)

PROJECT BUDGET: Itemize project expenses and proposed sources of income, including Regional Artists Project Grant. (13 sets)

RESUME: Your resume should be typed and include education, employment, exhibitions, performances, publications, commissions, and honors. Please limit your resume to a maximum of 4 pages. (13 sets)

REFERENCES: Provide letters of recommendation from up to three qualified persons. One letter is required. These letters should be from someone currently familiar with your work and the proposed project. The letters should address your excellence as an artist. (13 sets)

DOCUMENTATION: You must submit materials documenting art which you have completed in the past three years. You may submit reviews, programs, catalogues and/or: **for visual arts:** up to 10 digital images on CD, thumb drive, or photographs (original works of art not accepted). Include a work sample description sheet with your images; **for film:** DVD or CD; **for dance:** DVD or CD; **for drama:** DVD, CD, audio or video tape (list tracks to be listened to); **for playwright or literature:** 13 complete copies of manuscript (Limit of 20 pages); **for music:** DVD, CD or audio tape (List tracks to be listened to); **for equipment purchases:** 13 copies of manufacturer's specifications, web-page printout or catalog clipping; **for classes or workshops:** 13 copies of brochure, flyer, or resume of instructor. Please include a self-addressed postage paid envelope for the return of slides, photos, CDs, DVDs, tapes, or original manuscripts, or arrange to pick up your materials after receiving notification about your proposal. Materials not picked up within two months will be discarded.

The information contained in this application, including all attachments and supporting materials, is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge.
