**APPLICATION GUIDELINES:**

- All applicants must be Watauga County residents, or Watauga County Schools.
- Any county resident pursuing a program of study for his or her artistic development may apply for a scholarship.
- Scholarship money is awarded for an individual's development of his/her artistic goals. Example: workshops, camps, etc.
- Scholarships are not generally given for ongoing private lessons, except in cases of financial hardship. In this case, the teacher's qualifications should be provided.
- Scholarships are not given for the pursuit of a college degree.
- Grant money is awarded to schools for vocal music program support.
- Applicants should be as specific as possible regarding accomplishments, plans for study, goals, and expected use of the award money. You may attach up to three letters of reference as well as any additional information which you feel the judges would find helpful.
- Each year two to six awards are given, depending on available funding. The amounts of the awards vary. Final amounts for each award are at the discretion of the scholarship committee.
- Scholarship checks will be made out to the school, camp, or similar institution – not to the applicant. In the event of purchases, procedural arrangements may be made with the Executive Director of the Arts Council.
- Scholarship/Grant winners are asked to remain in contact with the Arts Council after receiving their award to share the results. If appropriate, they may be asked to demonstrate these in a public performance or exhibition.
- Application must be typed (If you would like, this form can be emailed to you. However, you must print it out and provide a paper copy in order for your application to be considered by the committee.)
- Please provide documentation of the proposed use of scholarship funds (i.e.: a brochure from a camp or workshop, etc.)
